DELEGATES' ASSEMBLY IVSI 2009

At the beginning of the meeting Kazuo (Niki) Den was commemorated, and posthumously awarded the honorary membership and the token of remembrance.

All delegates agree that this congress was very well organized, and that the Hungarian team of instructors, under the guidance of Katalin Egri, deserve great praise and appreciation. This congress showed again the congenial ambiance of the IVSI nations, and this should not be altered by big events.

A discussion of the eventual changes in the IVSI congress resulted in a recommendation to the presidium to closely monitor further developments. Holland and Belgium proposed to combine future congresses of IVSI and IVSS.

Alpe d'Huez, France, was chosen to host the next IVSI congress in 2013 .

It looks like from yesterday on there are even more delegates at the congress with I love snow stickers on their clothes, cars or even on their skins.

It was nicely snowing during the Japanese workshop, which caused problems for the photographers and the video crew, but not for the participants as there was no fog at all. After the practical presentation we could follow the Japanese method in two groups:

How can we lead smoothly the intermediate skier to parallel turns?

"Smoothly" means that we here aim to initiate the turn ef-

fectively by making the most of the energy of falling in nature, and not by exclusively using full muscle power, in a relaxed condition.

The Hungarian ski instructors got to the conclusion that there are a lot of similarity between the Japanese and the Hungarian method same as with their pentaton folk music of the two nations.



Examinations in Japan

The education of ski instructors in Japan is closely related to the conditions in society during the last 70 years, an era parallel to the history of the Japanese Ski Federation. Since the sixties, until the time of the great economic boom, the world of skiing developed very fast, to the effect that skiers could enjoy many facilities. Interest in skiing grew very fast and the number of skiers increased accordingly. At the time it was urgent to educate and train instructors. Then came the time of the information society,

during which the way of thinking of the Japanese changed tremendously. Skiers required facilities in many respects, and insisted on their multitude of interests. After the year 2000 society stagnates, and the skiing world drastically changed accordingly. The call in society for life long education and sports grew louder all the time. Therefore the Ski Federation pursues the goal to educate and train instructors of high quality in order to answer the needs of the skiing public.

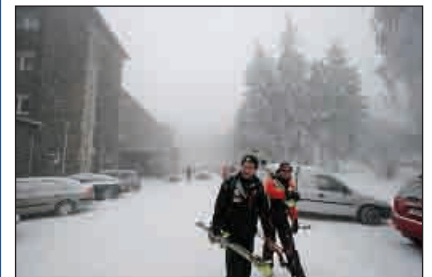
The youngest participant
